

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CENTER POINT, ALABAMA CHAPTER 38, SIGNS, ARTICLE III RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS, SEC. 38-73 GENERAL REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL SIGNS, SUBSECTION 4

The City of Center Point Code of Ordinances, Chapter 38, Signs, Article II Restrictions and Requirements, Sec. 38-73 General regulations applying to all signs, subsection 4 currently reads as follows:

- (4) No sign having flashing, traveling, or animated illumination shall be permitted in any zoned district of the City except for permanent signs located in commercial districts giving public service information such as, but not limited to, time, date, temperature, news or weather. These signs must not change more often than every 90 seconds and must be mounted ten feet or more from the ground. Lights required in authorized construction work zones would be exempt from this subsection.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Center Point, Alabama that the City of Center Point, Alabama Code of Ordinances, Chapter 38, Signs, Article II Restrictions and Requirements, Sec. 38-73 General Regulations applying to all signs, subsection 4 be amended to read as follows:

- (4) No sign having flashing, traveling, or animated illumination shall be permitted in any zoned district of the City except for permanent signs located in commercial districts giving public service information such as, but not limited to, time, date, temperature, news or weather. These signs must not change more often than every 30 seconds. Lights required in authorized construction work zones would be exempt from this subsection.

Repealer: All ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Center Point, Alabama that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

Severability: If any part, section or subdivision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or impair the remainder of this ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such holding.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication or posting as provided by law.
