

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-02

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 2005-25, AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF STORM WATER FEES ON PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF CENTER POINT, WHICH WAS ADOPTED DECEMBER 15, 2005 AND TO ORDAIN THAT FORMERLY ADOPTED ORDINANCE 2002-14, AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF STORM WATER FEES ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF CENTER POINT, WHICH WAS ADOPTED OCTOBER 10, 2002 REMAINS IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTER POINT, ALABAMA as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 2005-25, an ordinance approving and authorizing the levy of storm water fees on parcels of property located within the corporate limits of the City of Center Point, Alabama, which was adopted December 15, 2005 was improperly enacted, was not effective and is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Ordinance 2002-14, an ordinance approving and authorizing the levy of storm water fees on parcels of property located within the corporate limits of the City of Center Point, Alabama is hereby confirmed and continues to be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption, October 10, 2002.

Section 3. It is confirmed that Storm Water fees levied by Ordinance 2002-14 shall remain the same and shall continue to be collected in Center Point, Alabama pursuant to Ordinance 2002-14 from its effective date of October 10, 2002.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, approval and posting as required by Alabama law.




