3. Application must be submitted at least thirty (30) days prior to the Planning Commission's regularly scheduled meeting. Regularly scheduled meeting is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. **A rezoning fee of \$200.00 along with the postage for notification by certified mail for zoning meeting and public hearing before City Council to all property owners within the 500-foot radius of this property is required at the time the application is turned in.**
